We have produced/manufactured the following products for your company and have determined that they all are in compliance with the safety guidelines of the CPSIA (Consumer Product Safety Improvement Act), established into law in August 2008:


Modern Artists Go Fish for Art

Color of Art Postcard Books (4 titles – Red, Yellow, Blue, and Green)

All the materials used in the above products have undergone extensive testing, including but not limited to papers and substrates, inks, varnishes, UV Coatings, lamination films, binding adhesives, shrink wrap films, and other finishing materials used in the production of these products.

Although primary concern has been about the lead content of various materials, we also did extensive testing of many other known toxic ingredients which have occasionally shown up in some materials (flame retardants, sulfonates, phthalates, mercury, etc...). You can be assured that ALL of the materials and substrates used in these products contain none of these toxic materials, or are at levels well below the acceptable amounts designated by the CPSIA.

In addition to those products tested, we have also conducted random testing of all of the materials used at all of our contracted printing plants and binderies, and I can assure you that all of our suppliers use materials that are at or below these test results. To be clear, ALL of our manufactured products are guaranteed to be in compliance with the guidelines set forth by the Consumer Product Safety Improvement Act (CPSIA).
